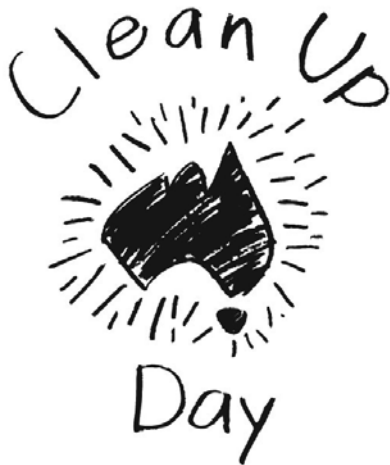


## Next Community Meeting

The program has been responsible for the development of effective crime prevention initiatives such as the Burglary Prevention Cocooning Project, Get to Know Your Neighbour Activities and Community Safety displays and education.

It is hoped that we can arrange for stall holders to come along and sell their wares, so if this is something that interests you then just add your name and stall details via the web Contact Page.

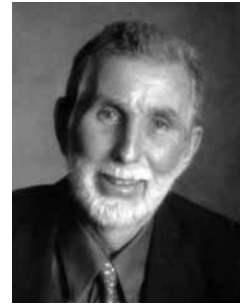

# Singleton Update from Cr. Brian Warner...



## Landscape Evaluation Consultation

The public consultation date for the Landscape Evaluation (the hills adjoining Mandurah Road) mentioned in previous newsletters has now been arranged for 12th February from 10.30 am to 3 pm at Coastal Community Centre, Tangadee Road, Golden Bay. Residents should soon be receiving a notification through the letter box of the date and venue. The details will also be in the Weekend Courier on 4th February.

## Overgrown vacant blocks

Several residents have contacted me regarding the amount of fuel (dry grass, dead flora etc) on vacant blocks. Owners have a responsibility to put in a fire break on their property; however it seems that the centre of the blocks are just becoming a possible fire hazard. If there is a block next to you that you are concerned about please write to the Council, with a photo if possible, expressing your concerns.

## Arsonists

In view of the recent fires, please be wary of any behaviour that you may think is suspicious and contact the police on 131 444.

## Golden Bay Structure Plan.

The consultation day for the amended Golden Bay Structure Plan held on December 4th was well attended and has raised several concerning issues. The plan includes more areas of higher density housing blocks, with several possible medium "high rise" buildings (similar to that approved in Secret Harbour Boulevard) creating 1,700 building lots. There is also proposed a neighbourhood centre of approximately

3,500 square metres including a supermarket of 1,800 – 2,000 m2 to be built less than two kilometres from Secret Harbour Shopping centre on Warnbro Sound Ave. The proposal will be advertised for public comment soon so please keep your eye on the local papers and the signs that should appear on Warnbro Sound Ave regarding the advertising period.

As your representative I will need to know your concerns so that I can support you in Council when the time comes.

The argument from the proposers is that it meets "Livable Neighbourhood" planning standards, however (in my opinion) the "Livable Neighbourhood" policy has many flaws.

## Footpaths

The footpaths along Wenn Road and Harmony Parade (Federation to Naval) have now been constructed. I will be advocating for the Mandurah Road footpath on the budget for 2011/12 whilst still hoping that the coastal path will become a reality in the future.

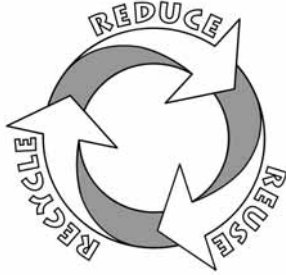

Cooking time: 30 minutes

### Ingredients

- 4 fresh turkey tenderloins\*
- 2 tablespoons olive oil\*
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 2 teaspoons dijon mustard
- 2 green onions, finely chopped
- 2 garlic cloves, crushed
- 1kg Sebago potato, peeled, roughly chopped
- 3/4 cup hot milk\*
- 40g margarine\*, chopped
- 3 green onions, finely chopped
- 20g parmesan cheese, finely grated
- Pepper, to season
- steamed green beans, to serve

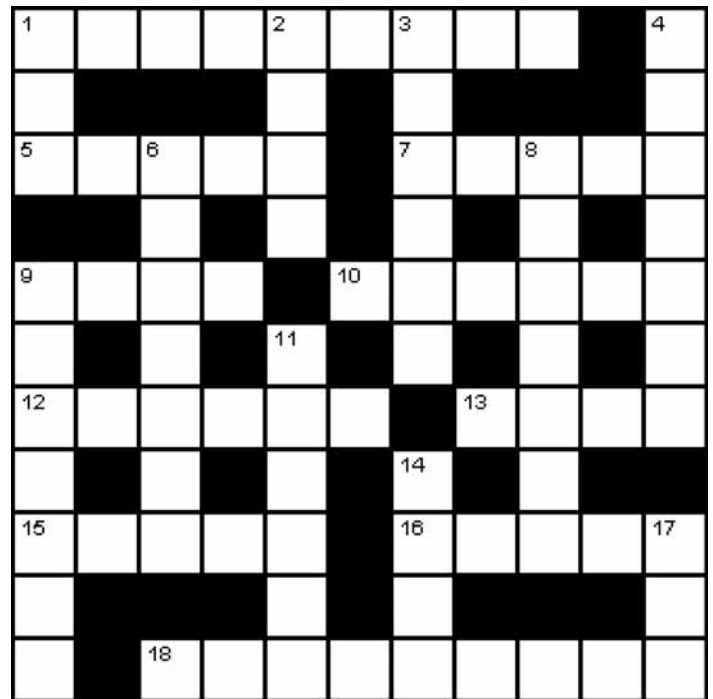

### Instructions

1. Combine turkey tenderloins, olive oil, honey, mustard, green onions and garlic in a bowl. Toss until well combined. Cover and refrigerate for 30 minutes.
2. Put potatoes into a saucepan and cover with cold water. Place over a high heat and bring to the boil. Reduce heat and simmer for 15-20 minutes or until tender. Drain. Add milk and butter. Mash until smooth. Add green onions and parmesan. Stir until well combined. Season with pepper.
3. Meanwhile, heat a large non stick frying pan or char grill pan over a medium high heat. When hot, add 2 tenderloins and cook for 3 minutes on each side or until golden and cooked through. Transfer to a large plate. Cover to keep warm. Cook remaining tenderloins.
4. Spoon parmesan mash onto 4 serving plates. Serve with turkey tenderloins and steamed green beans.

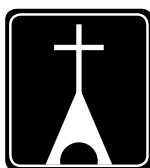

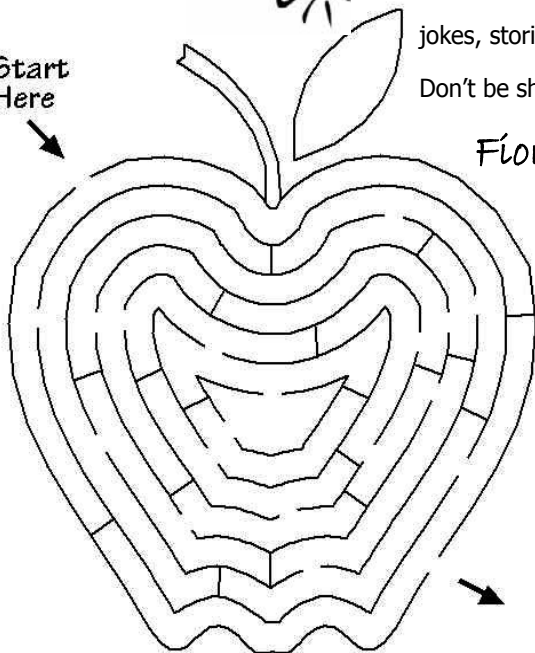

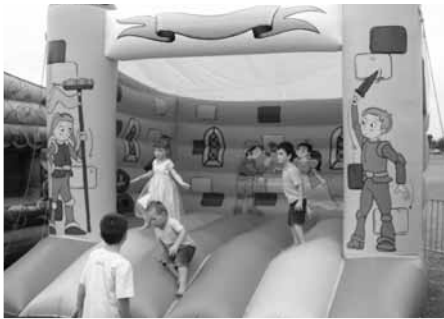
